





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Kindergarten Curriculum Map

Language Arts

- Identify all letters and sounds
- Apply phonemic awareness strategies such as phonics, word patterns, rhyming
- Make predictions and connect parts of a story to previous experience
- Recognize the elements of a story such as characters and setting
- Identify and answer questions related to the main idea
- Express ideas in simple, complete sentences
- Listen to an oral message and answer questions
- Retell a story that has been read orally
- Read sight and decodable words
- Write a complete sentence by the end of the year.
- Write first and last name correctly
- Use correct formation of letters as taught



Religion

- Recognize that God created the world
- Pray Hail Mary, Our Father, Angel of God, and Grace before meals
- Participate in Lent/Advent activities
- Introduce Bible stories
- Discuss the lives of saints
- Develop an awareness of home and church family
- Prepare for and participate in weekly School Masses
- Learn about the Rosary
- Participate in service projects



Math

- Identify and write whole numbers to 100
- Count by 1's, 5's, and 10's to 100
- Count by 2's to 50
- Demonstrate one-to-one correspondence
- Identify and solve simple addition and subtraction problems within 10.
- Organize and compare graphic data
- Understand place value (ones, tens, and hundreds)
- Identify days of the week and months of the year
- Understand greater than, less than, and equal
- Measure with standard and non-standard units

Social Studies

- Identify attributes of responsible citizenship
- Identify community helpers and the ways in which they serve others.
- Describe and respect customs and holidays
- Identify 2-dimensional shapes and 3-dimensional solids
- Recognize American symbols such as the flag and White House
- Recite the Pledge of Allegiance
- Use maps to locate places
- Identify what city, state, and country we live in.

Science

- Compare and contrast living and non-living things
- Identify stages in the life cycles of selected living things
- Identify the five senses and describe their functions
- Name the four seasons and describe seasonal and weather changes
- Describe the differences between solids and liquids
- Explore simple forces around us (magnets, gravity, and vibrations).



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
