<p>Committee Reports</p>	<p>Concessions Allyson Saxton went over the concession stand as the new chair. She will be cleaning out/organizing in the coming weeks as well as getting ready to place a supply order. We discussed increasing concession prices due to rising supply costs and to match prices seen at other schools. Also, parents will have the opportunity to sign up to work concession stands using an online platform. Parent discussed/suggested mandatory sign up for sports parents along with some form of accountability.</p> <p>Golf Outing Report Taryn Tissiere discussed the golf outing. We had lots of positive comments from participants about the outing including children and only being nine holes. Ashley Ralph suggested scheduling the outing on a consistent weekend year to year for easier scheduling for parents. We had 20 teams and made \$3,058.</p> <p>Restaurant Night (Sept 28) The profits from restaurant nights will be split evenly between the TAPS account and Sports Booster account.
